### Waste Management & Minimisation

Highways Maintenance Apprenticeship: Backfill materials such as limestone and sand are re used in any excavations. Waste tarmac where possible is used as a base or binder course. Any materials that need to be removed from site are taken away by a licenced waste carrier and recycled. Block paving and flagstones are cleaned and re-used within the training demonstrations.

Floorcoverings Apprenticeship: Accurate measuring and marking techniques are given to learners to minimise the waste from incorrect or over cutting of carpet vinyl etc.

Off cuts of carpet or resilient flooring where possible is to be used for single step installation to avoid large piece wastage.

General waste is collected by a registered waste carrier and is separated and recycled-zero to landfill. When ordering adhesives from manufactures, the unit size is to be kept to a minimum, this will ensure less wastage and contamination of the adhesive will be kept to a minimum.
